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# Ted Cruz Attends Cast Reunion of “The Office”



## Supreme Court Replaced

*Seats to be filled by Game of Thrones' council*

As of mid-March, President Obama began interviewing potential candidates to fill the supreme court seat once held by Antonin Scalia. With the short-list of potential candidates, the Judiciary Senate Committee met in secret to stop any movement with Obama's process in a replacement. Senator Cornyn, member of the committee states, "Honestly, we didn't look at any of the candidates' records. We just read their names, which all sounded horrible to us. It works well for the Republican party as it allows the next president -- personally I am rooting for Trump -- to appoint a new judge". Pressure from Democrats and members of the Republican party forced the committee to propose their own candidates or a suggestion to improve the system.

Sources close to the process of the committee state that the group decided to forgo upholding constitutional law and appoint entirely new members. In a unanimous 7-6 decision, previous Supreme Court members will be replaced by a high ranking individuals from Westeros. Cornyn states, "If anyone has an issue with the new council... well, let's just say you won't hear of anyone complaining". Previous members of the Supreme Court could not be found for comment on the matter.

An advantage of the new council, offered in a statement from the committee states, "We believe that the new council will uphold the original five canons of the Supreme Court while bringing in a new means to run the judiciary branch". President Obama has yet to offer his opinion on the change, but has scheduled a press conference Monday where he is expected to respond to the committee.

The new system offers the accused two means of trial: a trial in front of peers and trial by combat. In the trial in front of peers, each Supreme Court member will rotate and state slandering evidence against the defendant. Members of the accusing party will also be given a chance to speak against the defendant as well. Defendants will not be allowed a lawyer. Trial by combat places the defendant against an elected person who represented the people. If the defendant wins, he or she is innocent, and if the defendant dies during combat they are clearly guilty.

Critics of the new system assert that it will "bring the country back to the middle ages, undoing years of progress". "That's the plan" says Cornyn. "Keeping up this progress has become more and more difficult over the years and the committee felt it best to start over".



6. This dumpster feels really, really smooth, like a baby or an egg.





